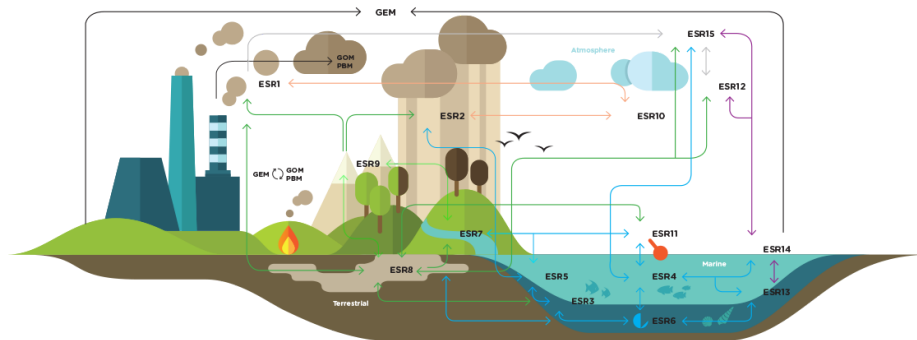




Welcome to GMOS-Train's first Newsletter!



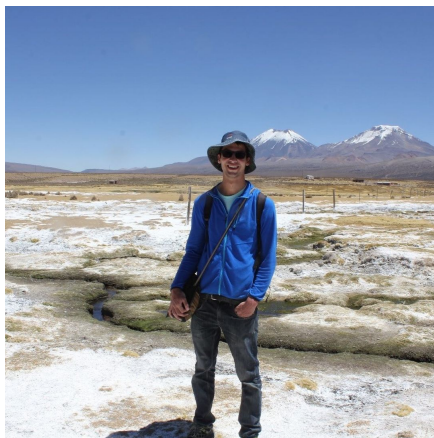
**GMOS-Train is a network-based,

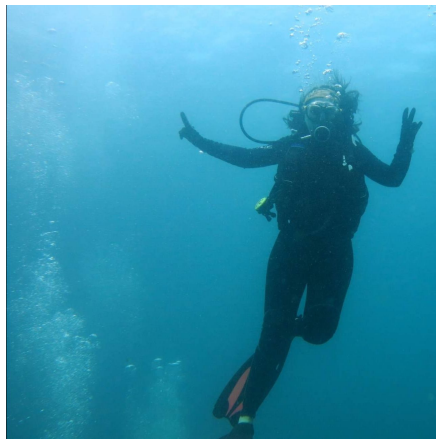
