Thank you for attending the **Microbial Technologies Week** taking place from 7 to 11 November 2022 in the premises of the Jozef Stefan Institute, in Ljubljana, Slovenia.

This event was organised by the SURFBIO and the GREENER H2020 projects aiming to bring together academia, industry, policy makers and regulators across Europe, interested in the following fields:

- **surface and colloid biology**
- **biotechnology**
- **environmental protection**
- **bioremediation technologies.**

The event hosted an industry workshop, a poster session and a hands-on lab training (open to the public), as well as project meetings, among other activities. In brief the open sessions are described below.

INDUSTRIAL WORKSHOP

Experts in materials science were brought together, addressing topics such as biofilm formation and interaction with surface materials, as well as applications on health, food and the environment sectors.

POSTER SESSION

A poster exhibition was organised including a 3-minute poster presentation. The session offered the opportunity for interaction among researchers involved in different EU projects within topics related to biology and material sciences, promoting networking activities.

TRAINING

A training workshop on “Experimental and computational approaches to study cell-cell interactions and cell-surface interactions” was also organised, offering a hands-on experience to the attendees.
